JOB DESCRIPTION-SUBSTITUTE TEACHER

The substitute teacher shall be assigned and supervised by the Building Principal. A formal evaluation shall only occur after consultation between the superintendent and the individual to be evaluated. The duties of the substitute teacher shall include, but not limited to, the following:

- 1. Maintaining, as fully as possible, the established routines and procedures of the school and classroom to which he or she is assigned.
- 2. Teaching the lessons outlined and described in the substitute teacher's guide as prepared by the absent teacher.
- 3. Consulting with the building principal before initiating any teaching routine or other procedures not specified in the substitute teacher's guide.
- 4. Reporting, in writing on the form provided by the school office, on the day's activities at the conclusion of each teaching day.
- 5. Verifying at the end of the teaching day with the building principal's office that his or her attendance will or will not be required on the following teaching day.
- 6. Following all policies, rules, and procedures to which regular teachers are subject to and which good teaching practice dictates.
- 7. Performing other tasks and duties as assigned.
- 8. Minimum educational preparation requirements.
 - A. Nebraska Bachelor's degree in education, or equivalent.
 - B. Hold a valid Nebraska teaching certificate, or a valid Nebraska substitute teaching certificate.
