**Appendix <sup>11</sup>1" to Option Enrollment Policy**

The following is Appendix "1" to Policy 502.2 for the 2016-20 School Year. The Board of Education hereby sets forth the maximum number of option students for the 2016-2017 school year in any program, class, grade level or school building or in any special education programs operated by this school district, based upon available staff, facilities, projected enrollment of resident students, projected number of students with which this school district will contract based on existing contractual arrangements, and availability of appropriate special education programs. Any program, class, grade level, or school building which has "0" as the No. of Option Students is hereby declared unavailable to option students due to lack of capacity.

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### Policy Pertaining to Capacity in Enrollment Option Cases (§79-232- §79-246)

It shall be the policy of the district, whenever an enrollment option application is made to the Elba district, to apply the following criteria in determining the capacity of the district to receive a student pursuant to such application.

1. For any applicant who would be enrolled in grades K-6 in the Elba District, if accepting such student would cause the class into which said student would be received to exceed the number fifteen (15), the application (may/shall) be rejected.

2. If a student who would be received under such an application is verified or believed to be verifiable for special education services, and if the receiving of such student would require the addition of a program, class, grade level, school building, or entering into a contractual arrangement with an additional staff member for the provision of providing appropriate special education programs or services, then such application shall be denied.

3. If an option enrollment application is made to the district for entry into the Elba District during the current year and if such application is made on or after November 1st of the current year, such application shall be denied.

4. If the district shall ascertain that a parent or guardian on an application has given false or substantively misleading information to the district, the district may reject a previously accepted application if the rejection occurs prior to the student's attendance as an option student.

5. If an application for enrollment option is to take effect during the school year the application is made, the district shall have forty-five (45) days to investigate and evaluate whether it has capacity as that term is used herein to provide educative services for such a student.

6. Nothing in this policy shall be construed to require the district to receive the sibling of an option student if the district is at capacity as provided herein except as otherwise be provided in section 79-240 Neb. Rev. Stat.
