JUVENILE COURT AND REFERRALS

When the juvenile court has taken jurisdiction of the matter involving a minor and assigned a probation officer, opportunity should be given the officer to interview the child at school free from observation of other children or individuals. It is not desirable or essential that the Principal or his or her agent be present at these interviews or visits. The probation officer has been duly authorized by the court following the proper acceptance of the case in juvenile court to investigate the matter for the court. In the event the child is placed on probation, the probation officer is authorized to take into custody any child under his or her supervision. In-case of such action, the school shall immediately notify the parent.
