STUDENT PHYSICALS FOR ATHLETICS

All boys and girls that participate in any athletics or practices must have a physical examination signed by a physician. The physical given may not be the same physical examination required of all freshman entering high school for the first time. The results of the examination and the physician's signature must appear on all local and state forms where it is required. All such examination results must be on file in the school where the student is to participate in athletics. In all cases, these forms should be signed first by parents to signify their permission and then by the physician. Only proper forms are to be used in all cases.
