From time to time your son/daughter may have occasion to be photographed for the newspaper, television, or the school's Internet web site. Frequently, news media will do stories on events occurring in school programs, presentations, sporting events, or other newsworthy happenings. As part of your child's educational opportunity, he/she may have the opportunity to publish documents and projects in the news media or on the school's web pages. Since pictures and individual work are personally identifiable information, you may have concerns about this type of information appearing in the news media or on the Internet.

The Elba Public School system is respectful of your child's privacy. In accordance with the Child's Internet Protection Act and the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act, it is our policy not to divulge any personally identifiable information in conjunction with student documents, projects, and/or individual photographs. Personally identifiable information includes students' full names, residential addresses, e-mail addresses, phone numbers, and/or students' ages and gender.
