## TRANSPORTATION IN INCLEMENT WEATHER

School district transportation vehicles will not operate when weather conditions due to fog, rain, snow or other natural elements make it unsafe to do so. Because weather conditions may vary around the school district and may change quickly, the best judgment possible will be used with the information available. Before school starts cancellation notices will be announced by the IRIS alert system, commercial radio, and television.

The final judgment as to when conditions are unsafe to operate will be made by the superintendent.

When weather conditions the IRIS alert system. Students will be returned to their regular dropoff sites unless weather conditions prevent it. In that case, students will be kept at or returned to school until they are picked up by the parents.
